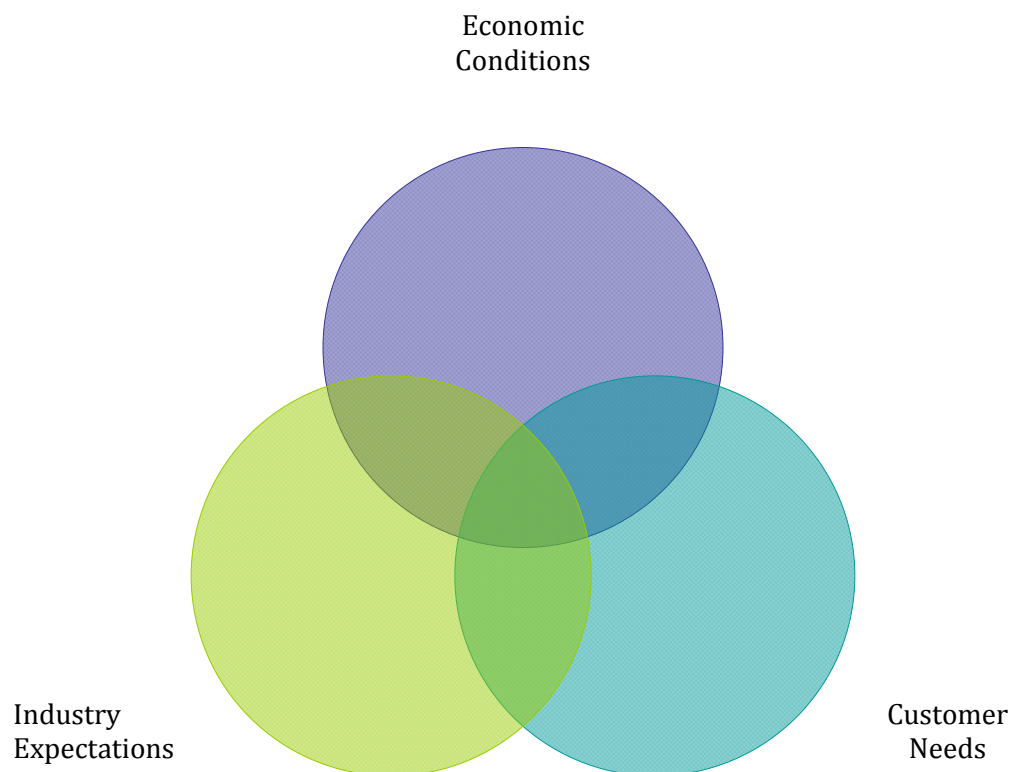

### Factors Affecting Companies in Today's Market Place

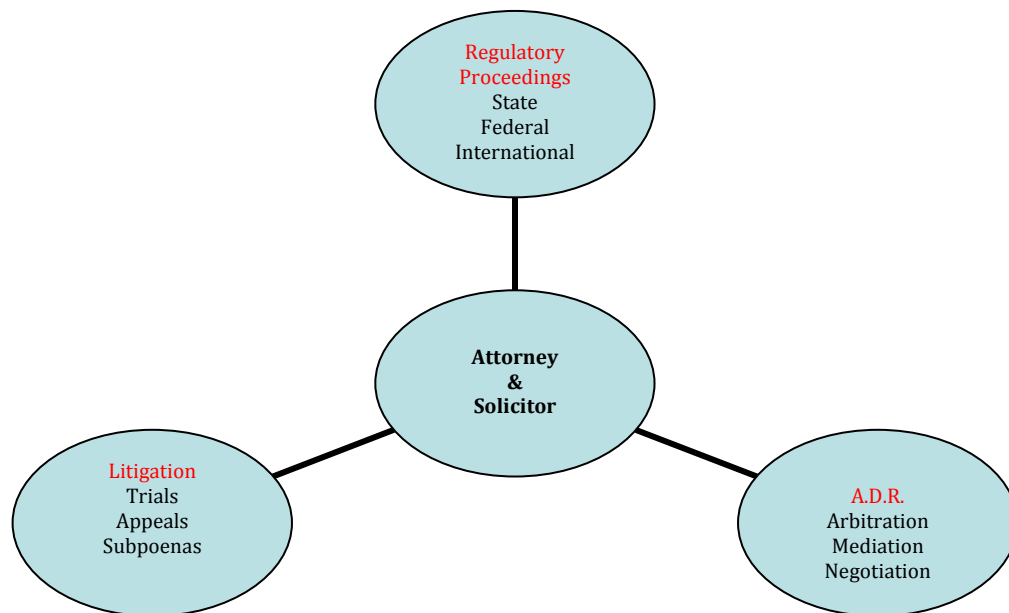
